#### **CALL FOR LABORERS**

Jesus is in his first year of public ministry in today's Gospel. He has already performed his first miracle (turned water into wine at Cana), talked with the Samaritan woman at the well and preached the Sermon on the Mount (and the Lord's Prayer, which is part of the sermon). He has healed numerous people and has recruited Matthew, who before his calling had been a tax collector. In the discourse we hear today, Jesus admits twelve others to share both his mission and his powers. All Israel is to be restored. In the Apostles' early apprenticeship, Jesus restricts their area of activity to the Jewsthe lost sheep of Israel. After his resurrection. Jesus charges them to "Go and make disciples of all nations" (Matthew 28:19).
