

## **PURIFICATION OF JESUS**

Biblical law taught that the first-born male of any animal had to be offered as a sacrifice to God. This applied to human children as well. Naturally most parents were reluctant to do this. Instead they could offer a substitute of a pair of pure white birds. Usually this happened 40 days after the birth. We celebrate this event on Feb. 2. The Gospel is read today because it shows the Holy Family performing their religious duties. They are blessed by God through two prophets.


