

#### THE REJECTED STONE

Psalm 118 today states, "The stone which the builders rejected has become the cornerstone." Those words became true for Jesus. In the time of Christ, workers had cut a large block of stone for building purposes at a stone quarry just outside the western wall of the city. Unfortunately they found a large crack in it, caused by an earthquake, so they left it in place and ignored it. The Romans used it for executions because it was near a public gate and could be seen by all as a warning against crimes such as treason. They accused Jesus of this because he claimed to be a king. The stone of Calvary literally became the cornerstone of our religion.
